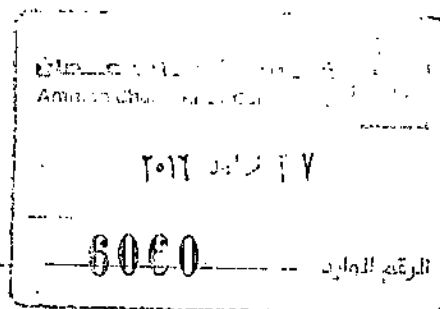

Abdur Rahman a leading Philanthropist, Educationist and Industrialist with the active support of eminent personalities and intellectuals of his time to uplift the Backward Communities through economic enhancement (entrepreneurship development, business opportunities, etc.), educational support and social development.

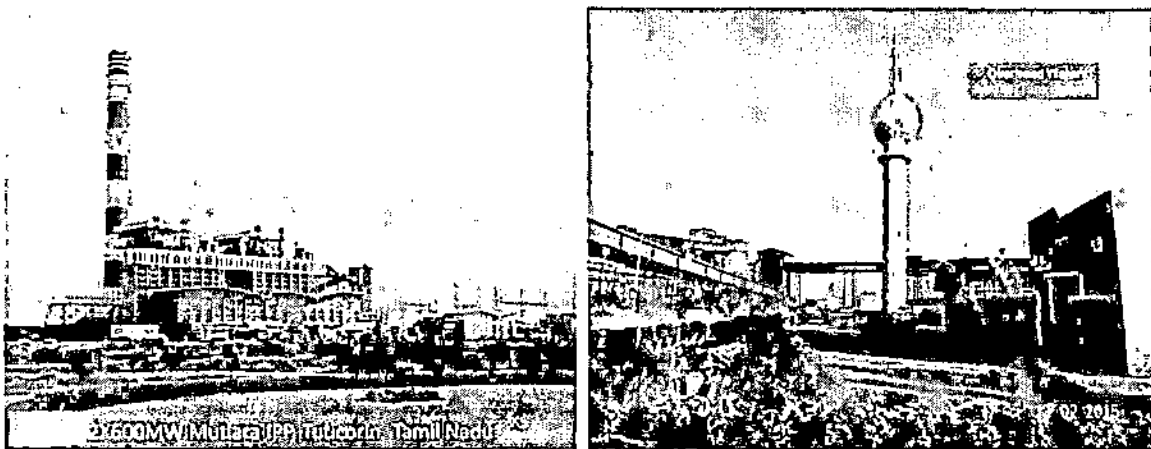

Currently, the United Economic Forum is headed by Mr. Ahmed A.R. Buhari, son of Alhaj Dr. B.S. Abdur Rahman, the founding father. Mr. Ahmed Buhari has done Master's degree in Shipping, Trading and Finance from City University of Business School, London, besides a Degree in Marketing from Bentley College, Boston, U.S.A.

President's Group Companies:

Mr. Ahmed A.R. Buhari is the Founder President and CEO of the C&O (Coal and Oil) Group, an Integrated Energy and Infrastructure company involved in Power Generation, Coal Trading, Shipping, Logistics and Industrial Parks. The group's Coastal Energy, was at one time the 2nd largest importer of Coal into India supplying approx. 10m tons to companies such as Tata Power, NTPC, etc.

As great believers in supporting Indian Infra structure requirements and the need for the community to take up Large Projects, Ahmed Buhari has recently commissioned their 1,200mw Coastal Energen's Mutiara Thermal Power Plant in Tuticorin investing over US\$ 1.3 billion. They also plan to expand their IPP to 2,800mw investing a total of US\$ 3 billion in Tamil Nadu making them among TN's largest Private investors and one of the community's largest on a Pan India basis.



C&O Group also plans to develop a 2,000 Acre Industrial Park along the 120km Madurai Tuticorin Industrial Corridor targeting investments from Renowned Global Companies. An Industrial Park aligned with Sharia principles is also being planned.

The above initiative are all fully aligned with Hon PM Modi's Make in India theme and Hon CM Jayalalithaa's Tamil Nadu Vision 2023 plans.

Under the leadership of Ahmed A.R. Buhari, United Economic Forum strives to become a premier organisation that serves the needs of the Muslim and backward communities at large. It aims to help its members make a mark in their chosen fields impacting Economic, Industrial, Educational and Social developments of the country.

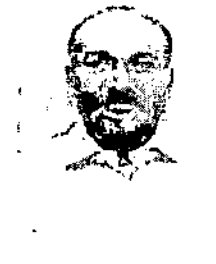

Entrepreneurship Development

For entrepreneurship development the forum aspires to play an important role in identifying entrepreneurs, motivating them to start new ventures that make use of financial and technical resources provided by the Government as well as the private sector.

In order to encourage entrepreneurship, a Project Department has been established to appraise Financial/Technical feasibility, assist in preparation of Project Reports, approach banks/financial institutions including investment bankers for private equity and Government departments to avail Incentives.

Chamber of Commerce

Shortly UEF will be relaunched as a Chamber of Commerce with a Vision to make our Community 'Formidable Contributors to the Nation' built on High Credibility and Integrity with the following objectives:

- ❖ To position our community as Highly Credible and ones with high Integrity
- ❖ To take forward PM's Make in India and CM's Vision 2023
- ❖ To position our community to get at least 0.1% (US\$ 2 billion - Rs. 12,000cr) of Mid-East SWFs of US\$2 trillion and 1% eventually.

Now UEF aims to bring on board 1,000 leading Businessmen, Technocrats, Professionals, Educationalists, Doctors, etc., to gain from and contribute to our Great Nation.

Women Empowerment

United Economic Forum believes in the empowerment of women as an important aspect of community service. The objective is to encourage NGO's and self-help groups work towards this goal and involve women in economic activities that will be beneficial to the backward / minority community. This can be achieved by entrepreneurship training for enterprising women to start their own businesses and facilitating finance through government subsidies and micro financing. Support and help will also be lent to those who need to market their finished products through networking.

Youth Wing:

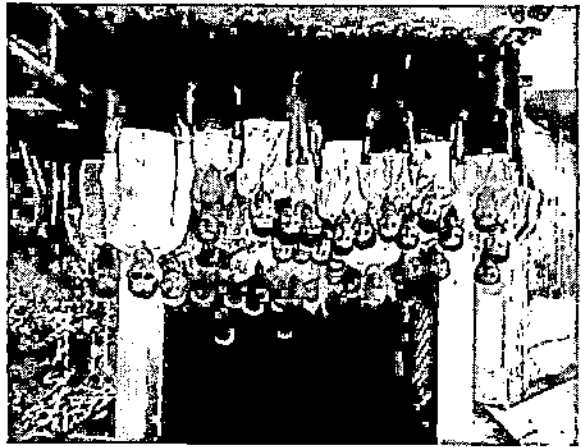
Since youth forms the base for development of any community, UEF has ambitious plans for setting up a separate youth wing for socio economic development of youth under the age of 35. This wing shall be totally committed to empower the budding entrepreneurs and encourage entrepreneurship. They will be guided and mentored to become successful entrepreneurs. The services of industrial experts, leading businessmen and bank officials shall be utilised for empowering them. Necessary assistance shall also be extended to those who need to market their finished products through networking.

Serving the needy in the Community:

United Economic Forum has a separate Trust which is committed to the task of uplifting deprived, under privileged and destitute children through support and training them into becoming self-reliant and responsible citizens of our country.

The founder, Alhaj Dr. B.S. Abdur Rahman, was keen on helping disadvantaged sections of the society and sought a number of ways to help & serve the needy children.

As a result the United Economic Forum Charitable Trust was started in 1994 with members from the management committee to specifically run the forum's children homes. Currently, the forum has four homes in Sakkarakottai (Ramnad), Ottapidaram (Tuticorin), Thanjavur, and an exclusive home for girls in Thiruvithancode (Kanyakumari) in Tamil Nadu. The total student's strength of the homes is about 200.

In addition to this, UEF also has a scholarship initiative, under which scholarships are awarded to poor and under privileged students to pursue professional courses. Candidates are awarded scholarships each year since 1997.

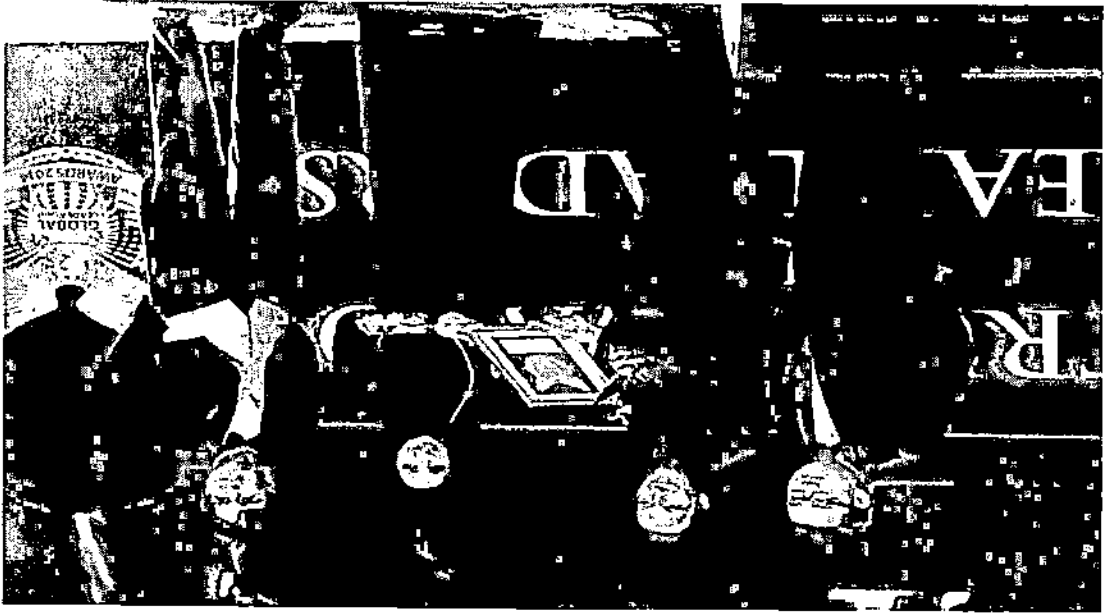

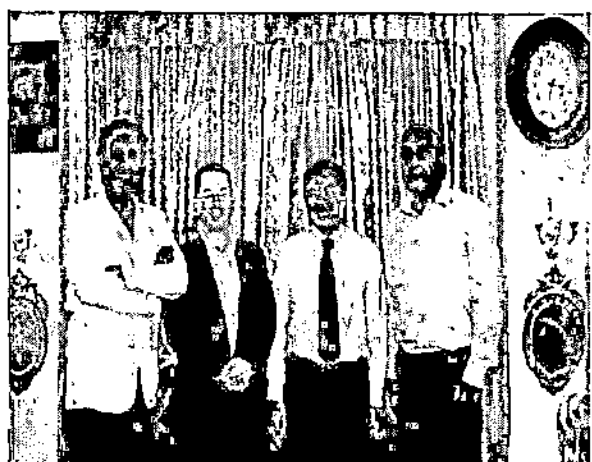

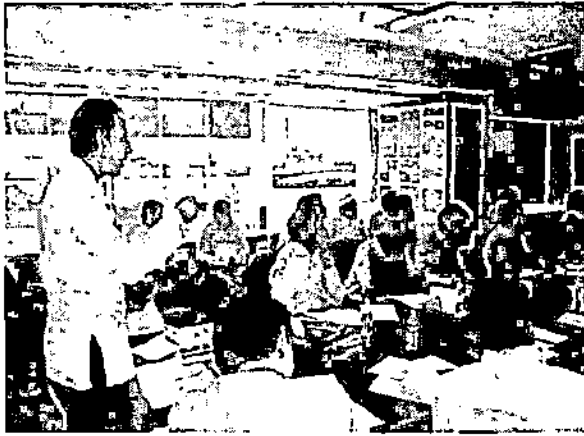

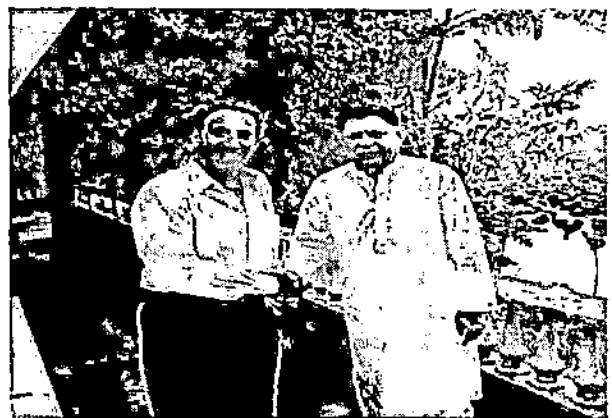
